Site Council Opportunity !

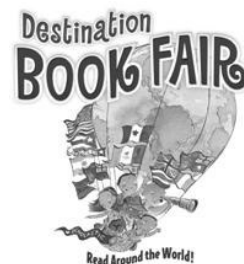

PICK-UPS, DROP-OFFS AND PARKING
